Disclaimer:

In the interest of equal treatment of applicants, the Frontex cannot issue a prior opinion on the eligibility of an applicant, an action or specific activities.

Question 1

If a school from Member State A applies for a grant in consortium with another school from Member State B, is to be considered that the experts from the Member State A are European experts for Member State B and vice versa?

RE: No. 'European expert' refers to an expert from an organisation of another Member State than the Member State of the applicant. The applicant can be a sole legal entity or a consortium of entities. In case of a consortium, a European expert should be an expert from an organisation of another Member State than the entities from the consortium.

Question 2

Can a member of an organisation be a 'European expert', if the expert is in mission/office in a country that is not a Member State?

RE: An expert can be considered a 'European expert' only if the expert is from a border and coast guard training school/centre/ academy from another Member State than the applicant or consortium Member States.
